# Social Impact Fund

Ingage created the Social Impact Fund in 2015 to formalize contributions to nonprofits, including monetary gifts from employees with a 1:1 match from Ingage.

**Grant Us Hope**





Grant Us Hope enhances mental wellness in schools by developing a community of students who team up to save lives. Voted by Ingagers as the 2019 winner, Grant Us Hope was awarded **\$41,000 and 100 pro bono service hours.**



The award helped them expand Hope Squad, a peer-to-peer suicide prevention program emphasizing early intervention, self-care and anti-bullying. Grant Us Hope reached across Ohio schools and underserved rural school students.



Ingagers provided pro bono consultation on software solutions for online learning. This allowed Grant Us Hope to scale their program to reach students in rural communities, saving lives.

The cost of distance learning setup was lower than expected, allowing Grant Us Hope to include four additional rural schools in the project.

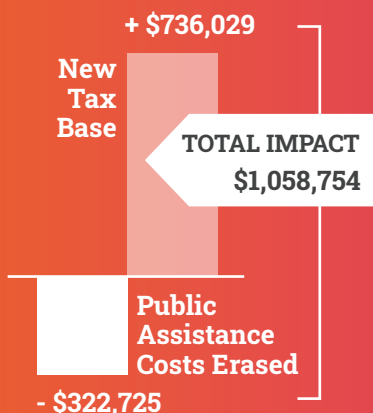

## ACCELERATOR

Since 2016, Ingage has hired **79 Apprentices** with 88% of successfully advancing their IT careers.

In three years, our community benefited from a cumulative impact of over \$1MM\*. Individuals with sustainable incomes contribute to the tax base and no longer qualify for public assistance.
